

Your Friday Night Racetrack is back!

The following information is intended to inform our race fans, race teams, event sponsors, employees and volunteers, on how the RCS will operate for the 2021 race season while still dealing with the ongoing COVID pandemic. The Red Cedar Racing Association (RCRA) will be following general guidelines as agreed upon between the RCRA and Dunn County Government officials. On March 17, 2021, the Dunn County Board of Supervisors voted to adopt the agreed upon Standard of Operating Procedures and allow the RCRA to operate RCS for the 2021 Race Season.

Maximum Attendance and COVID Protocols for the 2021 racing season

On Wednesdays prior to Friday race events, a review of new Dunn County COVID-19 positive cases will be done for the previous 7 days. Based on the average of those 7 days, Red Cedar Speedway and the Dunn County Health Director will agree on the MAXIMUM Grandstand Capacity that will be permitted for that weeks' race event based on the following criteria: ***Remember, on an average summer night, we operate at 50% grandstand capacity.**

GRANDSTAND CAPACITY STANDARDS:

No Grandstand attendance will be permitted unless the percent positivity (number of positive tests divided by total number of tests) is less than 5.0 percent.

Where maximum permitted capacity is **greater than 50%**, all attendees will be encouraged to follow the guidelines listed below.

Where maximum permitted capacity is **50% or less**, the following will be required by all attendees:

- Stay home when sick
- Practice good hand hygiene
- Practice social distancing outside of household
- Wear a cloth face covering

PIT SIDE ATTENDANCE: No attendance limit on competitors and crews. We do encourage pit attendees to follow current COVID-19 guidelines, for example; hand-washing/sanitizing and social distancing.

RACE TEAMS: The RCRA has ZERO plans to adjust payoff as it relates to grandstand attendance, it is our goal to race weekly for the posted RCS payoff in each class.

Signage will be posted throughout the facility as it relates to recommended protocols put forth by the CDC and Dunn County Health Department.

Every Wednesday evening the RCRA will announce the intended Grandstand Capacity for that weeks' race event. Grandstand Capacity for each weeks' events will be posted on our Facebook page and on our website. If you have questions, please reach out to any RCRA board member.
